

The Jubilee Logo

The logo shows four stylised figures, representing all of humanity, coming from the four corners of the earth. They embrace each other to indicate the solidarity and fraternity which should unite all peoples. The figure at the front is holding onto the cross. It is not only the sign of the faith which this lead figure embraces, but also of hope, which can never be abandoned, because we are always in need of hope, especially in our moments of greatest need.

There are the rough waves under the figures, symbolising the fact that life's pilgrimage does not always go smoothly in calm waters. Often the circumstances of daily life and events in the wider world require a greater call to hope. That's why we should pay special attention to the lower part of the cross which has been elongated and turned into the shape of an anchor which is let down into the waves.

The anchor is well known as a symbol of hope. In maritime jargon the 'anchor of hope' refers to the reserve anchor used by vessels involved in emergency manoeuvres to stabilise the ship during storms. It is worth noting that the image illustrates the pilgrim's journey not as an individual undertaking, but rather as something communal, marked by an increasing dynamism leading one ever closer to the cross. The cross in the logo is by no means static, but it is also dynamic. It bends down towards humanity, not leaving human beings alone, but stretching out to them to offer the certainty of its presence and the security of hope.

Sacrament Coordinators' Formation

I invite all those serving in this essential role to participate in this twoday course. You will be guided through all the necessary components of this multifaceted work – from the overall understanding to the very practical. This preparation will help alleviate some of the pressures and demands of this role and ensure your contribution is effective and inspiring.

Pilgrimage

Pilgrimage is a central theme of this Jubilee, reminding us that faith is a journey and a dynamic movement, deeper into the heart of the God who loves us and is always with us. During Lent a special opportunity is offered or Catechists to participate in a pilgrimage to designated Jubilee sites within the Archdiocese of Perth. These sacred spaces will enable us to walk in solidarity with one another as witnesses to God's enduring hope, and also to be united with the global Church in embracing the Jubilee's themes of reconciliation, mercy, and renewal.

Sacrament of Penance, Eucharist, or Confirmation Training

The workshops for the Sacraments of Penance, Confirmation and Eucharist are suitable for both new and experienced catechists. The sessions focus on one of the most essential aspects of the work of Catechists: sacramental formation.

You will be guided through the lessons, especially focusing on the theology of the sacraments and extending the range of activities so that children's learning experience and understanding of the sacraments is enriched.

Choosing Hope

This two-day course will draw upon the hope offered in the Good News and the richness of our tradition. The content will support us in living our alternative life-filled choice to be followers of Christ. With deepened knowledge and understanding we can respond with more confidently and with active hope to the needs of families, our parishes and our Church.

We look forward to welcoming you to various courses and events throughout the year. The team and I are privileged to be able to support your catechetical ministry. We are ever grateful for your dedication to this essential work.

HOW DOES THE CATECHIST FORMATION PROGRAM WORK?

INITIAL FORMATION

PART 1: PROVISIONAL ACCREDITATION

• Initial Formation Course

7 sessions consisting of Adult Faith Education and Religious Education Teaching Skills.

PART 2: FULL ACCREDITATION

Scripture & Theology in the Classroom
 7 sessions

Part 1 must be completed before enrolling for Part 2.

Requirements

- Endorsement of Parish Priest
- Participants must complete all sessions.

On completion of Parts 1 and 2 participants will be commissioned as Catechists (see flow chart on next page).

ONGOING FORMATION

CATECHIST CERTIFICATES I AND II

To be accredited with Certificate I or II Catechists must complete one unit in each of the following:

- Theology
- Scripture
- Religious Education
- Spirituality

A unit normally consists of 2 days, and a half-unit is 1 day.

Units can be accredited towards either:


- Certificate I; or
- Certificate II.

ADVANCED FORMATION

Advanced Formation is available to commissioned Catechists who have completed Certificates I and II. In 2025 those eligible for Advanced Formation may choose from the following:

- Centre for Faith Enrichment courses

- Information about biblical study scholarship, etc.
